The Governing Board is made up of 2 staff governors, 2 parent governors and 7 foundation governors and its main role is to support the school staff in its strategic planning.

We meet 6 times a year (2 each term) and as governors we review all aspects of the school from finance, school policies, curriculum, school performance data, Health & Safety, safeguarding, etc.
