Draw a picture of it and write a sentence telling us why.</p>	<p>Acting out stories</p> <p>Read the Easter Story and make some stick puppets to act it out (or use lego figures etc.)</p> 
<p>Addition</p> <p>Make two groups of toys (of up to 10 items each) Can you find the total by counting them?</p> <p>Challenge: Can you write the number sentence?</p>	<p>Sharing</p> <p>Have a teddy bears picnic! Put out 2 plates and see if you can share some food fairly (Start with an even number) Can you share it between 3 or 4 bears?</p> 	<p>Subtraction</p> <p>Make a group of your favourite toys. Can you take away some? How many have you got left?</p> <p>Challenge: Can you write the number sentence?</p>	<p>Doubles</p> <p>Can you practise your doubles to 5 using your fingers? <p>Phonics</p> <p>Use the RWI videos that are posted on DoJo each week to practise sounds and word reading.
