| Monday –<br>1    | Have your knowledge organiser at hand. Remember: acute angle is less than 90 degrees; right angle is 90 degrees; obtuse angle is 91-180 degrees; reflex angle is over 180 degrees.  |
| Tuesday –<br>2   | Have your knowledge organiser at hand.  |

| Thursday -<br>4  | Have your knowledge organiser at hand.  |
| Friday - 5       | Have your knowledge organiser at hand. If you have a mirror, it might help. If not, count the number of squares the point is away from the mirror line. What ever is on one side, has to be the same on the other side. You might have to alter both sides. |
