So just a few updates...

- If a child or adult has symptoms they <u>should still arrange</u> for a PCR test and isolate
- If positive the guidance still recommends isolating for at least 5 days.
- On day 5 and 6 a lateral flow test can be taken (packs can be ordered online). If these are negative and there is no temperature then pupils may return to school.
