Uniform Code

I wear my school uniform every day

Grey trousers or skirt

White shirt, polo shirt or blouse (tucked in)

Blue sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan

Blue Summer Dress/Grey Winter Dress

Sensible black shoes

Hair bands and accessories should be plain and simple

For PE, I will wear:

Plain black/navy shorts, plain white t-shirt, plimsolls/clean trainers for indoor PE.

Dark tracksuit and trainers for outdoor PE.

No jewellery can be worn during PE, ear rings <u>must</u> be removed. Long hair tied up.

Football kits/shirts are not permitted for PE.

If children come to school with incorrect PE Kit, we will find them correct kit to change into for the day and the class teacher will speak with parents/carers.
